

Honors Undergraduate Thesis – Melissa Dodd

- Alternative Formats approved by Burnett Honors College!
- Directed Readings > Thesis hours
- Proposal 1: substitutes DR with completion of NSCM Research Methods course (COM 3800, COM 3311, MMC 3420)
 - 90% or above in course
 - Produces an honors thesis proposal by the end of the course
 - Expand on individual or group projects
- **Proposal 2:** substitutes DR with applied research or project and Thesis with a *substantial critical analysis* of the process and product
 - Expand on individual or group projects
 - e.g. What historical, conceptual, and/or aesthetic approaches inform the student's work? How does the student's work model, relate to, answer or oppose these approaches? Etcetera.



Director's Honor Roll

 The Director's List is compiled each semester in recognition of scholastic honors.

- The requirements for inclusion are:
 - Must be a NSCM Degree-seeking undergraduate student;
 - Must earn a minimum 3.6 GPA;
 - Must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours;
 - Must earn no grade less than "B" (3.0); and
 - Must not achieve an "I," "U," "NC," or "WF" grades during a term.
