Peter Smith presented adjustments to Materials and Supplies fees for three courses in digital media.

DIG 2109	Digital Imaging Fundamentals	to show student art work in the form of posters that are various sizes or other works that are meant to be critiqued in a group setting. (280 enrollment)	<b>\$10</b>	<b>\$11</b>
DIG 3602	Physical Computing	purchase high tech materials for student projects and instructor demonstrations in 3D printing, laser cutting, and soldering circuit boards. (40 enrolled)	\$18	\$20
DIG 4138	Digital Sculpting	materials for student projects that allow to 3D print their digital 3D models for portfolios, showcases, exhibitions, and critiques.	\$12	\$22
