



## Liberal Arts Electives for Advertising/Public Relations, Journalism and Radio-Television Majors

Students majoring in **Advertising-Public Relations, Journalism, and Radio-Television** are **required** to complete 72 hours **outside** of the Communication and Media disciplines represented within the Nicholson School of Communication and Media (NSCM) as part of the 120 hours needed for graduation. The 72 hours must include a minimum number of **Liberal Arts credit hours, which are typically courses from the College of Arts and Humanities (CAH) and the College of Science (COS), excluding Communication and Media courses.** Film and Digital Media courses are taught within NSCM but can be used as Liberal Arts electives. SPC 1608 may also be used as a Liberal Arts course. The minimum number of Liberal Arts credit hours needed varies by program and catalog year. Please review your degree audit carefully or contact an NSCM advisor for assistance. Transfer course work used to satisfy NSCM courses must be approved by a NSCM advisor.
