Minimum Requirements

- Full-time student earning a degree in the Nicholson School of Communication and Media
- Completion of 30 credit hours
- Above satisfactory academic standing
- Evidence of service to UCF and/or the community
- Anticipated graduation date on or after Spring 2022
- Able to serve one full year (two semesters)
- Willingness to devote two hours per week to the NSCM Ambassador Program
- Availability to attend evening and weekend events or training sessions (if needed)
- Completed application form
- One letter of recommendation from a NSCM faculty member
- One letter of recommendation from someone familiar with your service activities
